

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

Visual depiction of the process and mechanisms




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

How to Create a Logic Model

- 1. Collect the relevant information
- 2. Describe the behavior to be addressed by the law
- 3. Define the outcomes
- 4. Describe the mechanisms
- 5. Draw the logic model
- 6. Verify the model


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
Logic Model Using the Theory of Planned Behavior


Logic Model for Cell Phone Laws



Hypotheses


- 1. Fear Laws & law enforcement practices influence perceived or actual behavioral control.
- 2. Guilt Laws & law enforcement practices influence attitudes towards cell phone use while driving
- 3. Shame Laws and law enforcement practices influence subjective norms towards cell phone use


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



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
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



