


MonQcle is a one-stop-shop, web-based legal research software used to navigate and organize complex legal texts to produce legal data for research and practice.

- Organize research and collaborate
- Build legal data across space and time
- Easily update and maintain data
- Visualize and share data

The Policy Surveillance Process



The **Codebook** is a complete list of all the questions coded in a legal dataset. It includes:

- The question type
- The variable name (for comparison with the data file)
- The variable values, and their labels







- Answers can be seen in the map tab, profiles tab, or in the table below the map in the map tab
- **Filter** by answers
- Also notice the **time slider** which allows you to track how laws, and specific questions and answer choices, have changed over time





1	FL	10-1-2013	Is there a state law on cellphone-use while driving?	EP	Caution Note/Flag – not sure that we need this, unless you think it is important to publish remove flag and note (not only for this entry but for all entries)	EP: Agree, Caution Note & Flag removed from all iterations.	Resolved.
1	FL	10-1-2013	What are the explicit exceptions to the law?	EP + SJ	EP answered: When the vehicle is stopped, Other SJ did not	SJ: I agree with Elizabeth. Operating an autonomous vehicle is probably the “other” category that she picked. I added her answers to my list of exceptions. EP: I marked other because there is an exception for receiving messages related to navigation, safety alerts, data used by the motor vehicle, and radio broadcasts. There is also an exception for autonomous vehicles. EP: I marked “When the Vehicle is Stopped” because of the sentence below; I think it <u>it</u> is probably enough to be coded: “For the purposes of this paragraph, a motor vehicle that is stationary is not being operated and is not subject to the prohibition in this paragraph.”	Resolved.

Post-production statistical quality control (SQC) describes the process by which a random sample of data are selected and tested to ensure the validity and reliability of the entire dataset.

Process Overview: Statistical Quality Control



Effective Dates

- A few things to consider
 - Difficulty in identifying historical dates
 - Fewer resources/less time to complete a project
 - What is the purpose of collecting the data?
